ABVP to hoist National Flag at 1.25 lakh plus places

Committees will be formed in all states to ensure implementation of NEP

Entering into the 75th year of independence, Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad has planned to hoist the National Flag at 1,28,335 plus places across the country. ABVP will also work on plans like internships, Tiranga march, social media campaigns, short films on forgotten warrior, etc. throughout the year.

The one-day National Executive Council meeting of Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad was held on August 1, 2021 in Bhopal through virtual and physical medium. The plans for the coming year, campaigns and programs were announced during the meeting.

ABVP has decided to constitute a committee in each state for the timely implementation of the National Education Policy. This committee will send suggestions to the government, administration and universities in their states and will strive for immediate implementation of the same.

2022-23 also marks the 75th anniversary of ABVP. For its celebration, in the next two years, ABVP has decided upon big campaigns for which extensive preparations have begun. Apart from this, it has been decided in the National Executive Council to expand the 'Parishad Ki Paathshala' activity nationwide and to establish 'Ritumati' campaign for women's health and empowerment as an amplitude across the country.

Two resolutions and an appeal were passed in the National Executive Council meeting. Resolution 1 referred to the problems of the education sector during the Covid-19 period and a solution was demanded from the Central and State Governments and the second resolutions discusses the current scenario of the country and calls for action. ABVP has also appealed to the youth nationwide to join the celebrations of independence throughout the year and remember the unsung, forgotten heroes of our independence.

ABVP's National General Secretary Sushri Nidhi Tripathi said, "In the three-day meeting, there was a detailed discussion on the solutions to the challenges faced by the education sector during the Covid-19 period. This year India will enter the year of 75th anniversary of independence and a special campaign has been planned so that this year is celebrated with enthusiasm by the citizens of the country."
