Elections for the ABVP's National President and National General Secretary held

Presently, he serves as a Professor and the Head of the Department of Education as well as the Dean of the School of Education at the Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Lucknow. He has authored and edited six books thus far. To date, more than 112 of his research papers and articles have been published in various national & international research journals and seminars. His articles have been featured in the newspapers on subjects related to education. He has been an Associate at the prestigious Indian Institute of Advanced Studies, Shimla. In 2017, he was awarded the Yogiraj Baba Gambhir Nath Gold Medal for Best Teacher by the Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh. He is a member of various important committees in Uttar Pradesh related to educational reforms and implementation of the National Education Policy. A deep thinker on educational and social issues, he has played a significant role in advancing organizational work in Uttar Pradesh.
