ABVP demands to increase the CUET-UG examination centres (cities) across the country, writes letter to the UGC Chairman.

CUET examinations should be conducted in government and credible institutions: ABVP

The number of CUET- UG examination centres in North East India is very less, examination centre must be increased: ABVP

ABVP has written a letter to UGC Chairman regarding the CUET-UG examination conducted by NTA and has raised the demand to increase the number of centres (cities) of the examination, to conduct the CUET-UG exam in government and credible institutions and appointment of government employees of central and state govt as examination officers.

At present various important examinations of the country are being conducted by the NTA, therefore to conduct the examinations in CBT mode, there is a need to increase examination centres in various cities of the country and also to strengthen the digital infrastructure at a rapid pace. Recently, it has come to the notice that during the conduction of various computer-based examinations by the NTA, there is a lack of credible basic computer labs in various regions of the country especially the students of Northeastern states face a lot of problems due to less number of centres in the region and location of centres in far-flung areas.

ABVP's National General Secretary Yagyavalkya Shukla said, "NTA has made less examination centers for CUET UG. ABVP demands that the number of examination centers should be increased. It should be kept in mind that the nearest examination centre option should be available to students in different states including the northeastern state of the country and the examination must be conducted in cent percent transparent manner across the country.
