ABVP submits memorandum to the AICTE Chairman.

Technical education in Bharatiya languages be made available.

Technical Education must be in line with the requirements of the Industrial sector: ABVP

A delegation of the Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad met the AICTE Chairman Prof. TG Sitharam and submitted a memorandum over issues related to the Technical Education sector. ABVP raised issues such as focus on complete implementation of the National Education Policy in Technical Institutes, bringing technical education in line with the demands of the industry and provision of the increased opportunities for the provision of technical education in Indian languages, with the AICTE Chairman.

ABVP also took up major demands pertaining to provision of quality technical education, adhering to the standards of the same, redressal of the lack of adequate number of professors by felicitating the appointment of qualified professors, timely declaration of examination results, practical education based on modern laboratory infrastructure, urging that these be looked into seriously and worked upon at the earliest. ABVP also demanded that AICTE-IKS division should provide internships based on Indian knowledge system like previous year, with prior notice containing more information and details.

Yagyawalkya Shukla, National General Secretary, ABVP, said, "Various Technical institutions lack the basic infrastructure, qualified professors and modern laboratories etc. We must stop technical educational institutions across India from descending into mere degree providing machines and must ensure quality education in these institutes. Steps must be taken to prepare students according to the rigours and demands of the industry and significant efforts need to be made towards skill development. ABVP has made the AICTE Chairman aware of these issues related to technical education and we hope that earnest and consequential steps will be taken on the issues raised by ABVP."

The ABVP Delegation that met the AICTE Chairman Prof TG Sitharam comprised of ABVP National General Secretary Yagyawalkya Shukla, National Secretaries Hushyar Meena, Sakshi Singh, Biraj Biswas, Harikrishna Nagothu and Ankita Pawar.
