After the decision of the Supreme Court, Government should decide to extend the date of NEET PG 2022: ABVP

In the context of the problems being faced by the students regarding the exam date of NEET PG 2022, after the decision given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court today, the government should take a positive decision in the interest of the students. The Supreme Court has decided not to interfere, leaving the decision to extend the exam date to the government.

It is to be known that the counselling process which was supposed to be completed in March, ended on May 7th due to order by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and even the counselling in many states was cancelled because of which many seats remained vacant and due to the delay, the allotted seats of many students were also cancelled. The problem of the students was also put before the Union Health Minister through a memorandum by the delegation of ABVP and the demand of opening a link for registration of the students whose allotted seats were cancelled was also put forward.

National General Secretary Of ABVP, Nidhi Tripathi said, "Due to the conflict between the counselling process of NEET PG 2021 and the date of examination of NEET PG 2022, there is not enough time to prepare. Hon'ble Supreme Court has left the decision to the government. Government should decide on the interest of students at the earliest and should extend the dates of NEET PG 2022. We also urge the students to keep preparing for the exam. We are is trying our best the extension of the exam date."
